

## NSW DRIVER AUTHORITY COURSE

To obtain a driver authority to drive a bus in NSW you must complete a course approved by the NSW bus & coach association (Bus NSW) and meet the requirements of Transport for NSW as listed below.

- ⇒ Current unrestricted NSW drivers licence of the appropriate class held for 12 months in the last 2 years.
- ⇒ Be of good repute and a fit and proper person with a current crimtrac report.
- ⇒ Pass a medical assessment.
- ⇒ Payment of the appropriate fee to Transport NSW, currently \$70.

The training is delivered in partnership with Into Training, South Australia and is formatted to the specifications of the NSW bus & coach association.

The driver authority course consists of 5 modules as outlined below.

- 1. Workplace legislation and Procedures.
- 2. Driver welfare and safety.
- 3. Driver fatigue.
- 4. Managing breakdowns and emergencies.
- 5. Dealing with passengers.

The training is generally conducted in a one day session.

Upon successful completion the certificate can be presented to Transport for NSW with a completed medical and provided all other requirements are met a NSW driver authority can be issued.

Successful applicants can be introduced to one of the local bus companies who have indicated that they are hiring at that time.

If you need to resit your assessment and you are in a remote location you can ask to RESIT OBSERVED BY JP (AT REMOTE LOCATION) bear in mind the cost for this as listed below does not include any fee charged by the JP
